The Millennium Green. In June 1998 the land was under agriculture with the small pond in the middle of a ploughed field.









In November 1998 work started with the clearing and ploughing of the land





Spring 1999 saw the star of the sowing of the meadow grass







By February 1999 Cleeve prior First School along with villagers were already planting the trees we see today. This was followed in December with the planting of a grove of yew trees

In August 1999 it became apparent that in wet weather the Pond would flood the adjacent meadow





So in the summer of 2003 the pond was enlarged to take up the extra water and to help the development of wildlife









The work to the pond generated a large amount of spoil and this was deposited at the top of the green to form a semi circular viewing mound
