Cleeve Prior Neighbourhood Plan Referendum

The development of the Cleeve Prior Neighbourhood plan has been a lengthy task to which many local people have devoted significant time and expertise in research, consultation with parishioners and experts, also liaison with public authorities.

As was reported earlier this year, we suffered a setback when the final examiner rejected some significant parts of the draft plan which necessitated a restructuring of the document. This has now been completed and a new draft lodged with and approved by, Wychavon District Council.

The final stage for official adoption of the Plan is now upon us in the form of a referendum for the residents of Cleeve Prior and this will take place on Thursday 1st February 2018.

Our Neighbourhood Plan is an important document that encapsulates a mass of information about Cleeve Prior and reflects the stated wishes of the Community for the future of the Village and its environment. When adopted it will be a vital tool for Wychavon District Council in making major planning decisions.

The question that will be asked in the Referendum is:-

“Do you want Wychavon District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Cleeve Prior to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

The Parish Council, as sponsors of the Plan, hope that all eligible voters will support adoption on 1st February.
